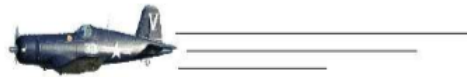

#### **BYLAWS of THE FLYING PILGRIMS Revised April 2010 Article V - Dues and Assessments**

**Section 5.02** - Partial Year Dues for new members are to be assessed and collected as follows, rounded up to the nearest dollar, when inducted:

- A. January 1 to June 30 - full Dues.
- B. July 1 to October 31 - 50% of full Dues.
- C. November 1 to the end of February - full Dues applied to the following year.
- D. Dues of any renewing member, paid after the end of February, but before April 30, shall incur a late payment Penalty.**
- E. After April 30, non-payment shall be considered voluntary termination.

### *Another Note to all Pilots:*

***While at the field, club officers are still observing field safety issue regarding the flite path!***

All pilots should contain their flight pattern to north of the runway centerline.

**Flying down the centerline should not be considered the norm.**

### **FIELD OPERATION SAFETY starts with all members vigilance!**

Follow the "SEE AND AVOID" GUIDANCE set forth by the AMA.

Call out warnings of approaching full size aircraft.

Fly at a safe low altitude relative to oncoming full size aircraft.

Because of our location relative to Willow Run Airport, we have a **400 Ft.** height restriction.

Commercial test development of UAV's is prohibited at the field.
