## Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS):

From the FAA web site:

Owners must register their UAS **online** if it meets the following guidelines: Weighs more than 0.55 lbs. (250 g) and less than 55 lbs. (25 kg). *Unmanned Aircraft weighing more than 55 lbs. cannot use this registration process and must register using the full size aircraft registry process.*

Registration online is easy and simple requiring the register to be 13 years of age or older and a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident. Online registration will require a credit card to pay a \$5 fee. If you register before midnight EST, January 20th, 2016 and your \$5 registration fee will be refunded!

After you register you will be emailed a certificate which looks like this:

For U.S. citizens, permanent residents, and certain non-citizen U.S. corporations, this document constitutes a Certificate of Registration. For all others, this document represents a recognition of ownership.

For all holders, for all operations other than as a model aircraft under sec. 336 of Pub. L. 112-95, additional safety authority from FAA and economic authority from DOT may be required.

#### Safety guidelines for flying your unmanned aircraft:

Fly below 400 feet

Never fly near other aircraft

Keep your UAS within visual line of sight alcohol

Keep away from emergency responders

Never fly over stadiums, sports events or

. . . .

Never fly under the influence of drugs or alcohol

Never fly within 5 miles of an airport without first contacting air traffic control and airport authorities
